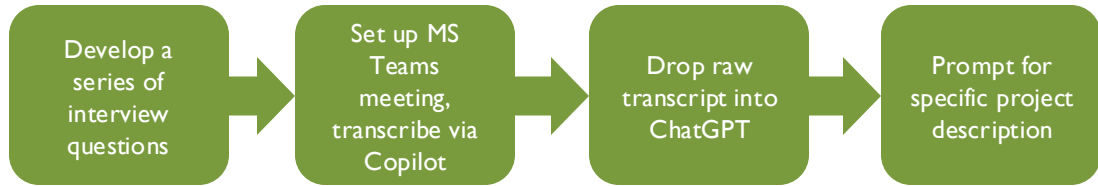


**EXAMPLE 1 – WRITING PROJECT DESCRIPTIONS**

**EXAMPLE 2 – SHORT FORM PERSONNEL BIOS**

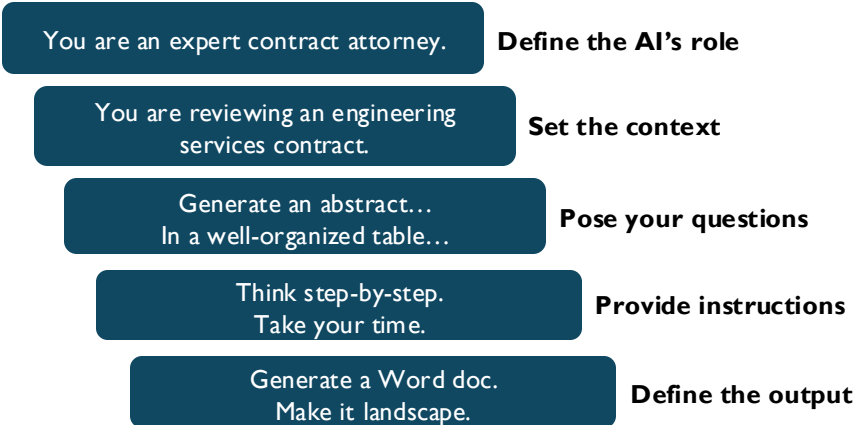


This is Kyle Anderson's long form resume.

This is an RFP from Nebraska DOT.

You are an expert consulting engineering marketer. I have provided Kyle Anderson's long-form resume. FHU is pursuing this RFP. For the technical proposal, write a 200-word personnel bio for Kyle, focusing on his experience that would apply to this project. Kyle's role on the project is principal-in-charge, as well as public involvement and community engagement. Focus less on environmental, and more on interstate and interchange projects. Produce a Word doc without any text formatting.

## EXAMPLE 3 – ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT REVIEW



This is a document that describes FHU engineering services contract standards.

This is a transcript of a conversation about FHU contract standards.

This is a document that provides details on FHU insurance coverage.

This is a contract for engineering services that needs review.

You are an expert contract attorney.

You are reviewing this engineering services contract for compliance with FHU standards as well as accepted industry standards.

Generate an abstract of this agreement in less than 100 words.

In a well-organized table, identify the following information: the parties, the effective date, key obligations of each party, termination, indemnification, and limitation of liability.

In another well-organized table, identify contract insurance requirements, and identify where FHU insurance fails to meet, meets, or exceeds these requirements.

In another well-organized table, identify the major risks that impact FHU. For each risk, explain the potential impact and suggest feasible ways FHU can mitigate this risk. For each risk, identify the specific language that you are concerned about.

Think step-by-step. Take your time. Produce a Word doc with the results. Make the Word doc landscape to improve readability.
